








GO HOPE GRANT





- G70 is seeking to award \$200,000* to an organization(s) that will develop and implement an initiative that will "create hope for Hawaii's future generations".
- Think Big. Think Bold. Think Outside of the Box.
- The winning proposal(s) should be new ventures which did not exist previously but can be initiatives which expand the reach of an existing program. Consider partnering with other organizations to enhance the capabilities and reach of your proposal.
- Collaborations and interdisciplinary approaches are a natural part of G70 culture, and fundamental to increasing our impact in the community.

^{*} Intention is to provide the greatest flexibility in consideration of awards. As such, no set amounts for the awards and no specific timelines are given. Recipient organization must be a non-profit but partners can be for profit.

Organization name, chief name, chief title, address, headquarters, incorporation yr, mission statement (2000 character max), staffing, service locations, ages served, demographics, annual operating budget.

Proposals point of contact name, email, and phone number

Project Team Structure



selection criteria

Short List (4-5 target goal)


- 1. Applicants must be a non-profit organization with 501(c)(3) tax exempt status
- 2. Evaluation by G70 committee based on selection criteria

Final Selection from G70 Principals

- 1. Interview
- 2. Disclosure of relationship with organization
- 3. Deliberation based on selection criteria
- 4. Majority vote for selection

Selection Criteria (internal score card)

- 1. Hawaii communities served
- 2. Impact of proposal on this community
- 3. How achievable is the proposal
- 4. Creativity / Innovation / Uniqueness
- 5. Organizations who partner/collaborate with other organization to multiply the impact of their proposal

By responding to this RFP the recipient organization agrees to submit the following each calendar year proposed in the submitted timeline:

- 1. Status report on progress
- 2. Budget updates
- 3. Timeline
- 4. Photos (if relevant/available)
